



## 2011 Worship & Study 40 Day Prayer Calendar

October 9-Nov 17

**Day 1: (October 9)** Pray and praise God for He is Sovereign and it is He who began this ministry 56 years ago.

1 Chronicles 29:10b-11 “Blessed are You, Lord God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever. Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in Heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the KINGDOM, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all.”

**Day 2: (October 10)** Pray Jehovah Raah- The Lord our Shepherd to be in control of the entire conference.

Ezekiel 34:14-16a “I will feed them in good pasture, and their fold shall be on the high mountains of Israel. There they shall lie down in a good fold and feed in rich pasture on the mountains of Israel. I will feed My flock, and I will make them lie down,” says the Lord God. “I will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick.”

**Day 3: (October 11)** Pray and ask God to show us individually how to prepare for Worship & Study.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 “Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit Who is in you, Whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God’s.”

**Day 4: (October 12)** Pray for our Chiefs of Chaplains. May the Lord God bless our Chaplains; Chaplain (MG) Donald Rutherford, Chaplain (RADM) Mark L. Tidd, Chaplain (MG) Cecil R. Richardson.

Daniel 2:20-21 “Praise be to the name of God forever and ever, wisdom and power are His. He changes times and seasons; He sets up kings and disposes them. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning.”

**Day 5: (October 13)** Pray for your local installation Chaplains. May they be blessed beyond measure as they daily abide in Christ.

John 15:5 “I am the vine, and you are the branches, he who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.”

**Day 6: (October 14)** Pray for Leslie Pedro, our Worship & Study Conference Coordinator and the rest of the European Regional Board. May God bless the work of their hands and may He give them times of rest.

Mark 6:31 “Then, because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to rest, He said to them, ‘Come with Me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest.’”

**Day 7: (October 15)** Pray for all evil to be lifted from the Edelweiss hotel before we arrive.

Ephesians 6:12 “For our struggle is not against flesh and blood but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.”

Psalms 19:14 “May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.”

**Day 9: (October 17)** Pray for our speakers (Beth Mills, Jim and Bea Fishback, Nyika Taylor, Victoria Robinson, and Chris Young) to hear clearly every word they are to speak to us at the conference.

Isaiah 30:21 “Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, ‘This is the way; walk in it.’”

**Day 10: (October 18)** Pray for Gaelle Lauret (worship leader) and for our worship time at conference.

John 4:24 “God is Spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.”

**Day 11: (October 19)** Pray for our workshop leaders to receive wisdom for their classes.

Ephesians 1:17 “I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.”

**Day 12: (October 20)** Pray for the actual teaching of the workshop leaders to fall like rain.

Deuteronomy 33:2-3 “Let my teaching drop as the rain, my speech distill as the dew, as raindrops on the tender herb, and as showers on the grass. For I proclaim the name of the LORD: ascribe greatness to our God.”

**Day 13: (October 21)** Pray for the conference committee to be strengthened for the work at hand.

Nehemiah 6:9 “For they were trying to make us afraid, saying, “Their hands will be weakened in the work, and it will not be done.” Now therefore, O God, strengthen my hands.”

**Day 14: (October 22)** Pray for all the women attending conference to receive understanding regarding all the wisdom shared during Worship & Study.

Nehemiah 8:8 “They read from the Book of the Law of God, making it clear and giving the meaning so that the people could understand what was being read.”

**Day 15: (October 23)** Pray for all the women attending conference to know God in a deeper way through this conference.

John 17:26 “I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them.”

**Day 16: (October 24)** Pray for the Leadership Selection Committee to have assurance of God’s chosen women for the incoming International Board.

1 Samuel 16:12 “So he sent and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, with bright eyes, and good looking. And the LORD said, “Arise, anoint him; for this is the one!”

**Day 17: (October 25)** Pray for this conference to glorify God in every way.

Revelation 4:11 “You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created.”

**Day 18: (October 26)** Pray for God’s Spirit to be within us at the conference.

Ezekiel 36:27 “I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.”

**Day 19: (October 27)** Pray for us to be the aroma of Christ at the hotel.

2 Corinthians 2:14-15 “Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.”

**Day 20: (October 28)** Pray for all the women who need to hear a special word from God at the conference. (Those women who might be going through an especially difficult time)

Zephaniah 3:17 “The LORD your God is with you, he is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, He will quiet you with his love, He will rejoice over you with singing.”

**Day 21: (October 29)** Pray for the peace of all households affected by our conference.

2 Thessalonians 3:16 “Now may the lord of peace Himself give you peace always in every way. The Lord be with you all.”

**Day 22: (October 30)** Pray for our husbands and our children to be blessed while we are away.

Philippians 1:3-6 “I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with joy, for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this very thing that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.”

**Day 23: (October 31)** Pray for God to be heard at conference and that nothing would hinder His will. May we have eyes to see and ears to hear.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 “For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.”

**Day 24: (November 1)** Pray for us to increase in prayer as a global ministry.

1 Thessalonians 2:17 “Pray With Out Ceasing.”

**Day 25: (November 2)** Pray for travel mercies for those coming to conference.

Psalms 121 (all)

**Day 26: (November 3)** Pray for the unity within our diversity as we arrive to worship and study together. We are all His. May we remember He is our Father.

Psalms 24:1 “The earth is the LORD’s, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein.”

**Day 27: (November 4)** Pray for us to remember that we serve a Holy God and His name is Holy. Increase our reverence and awe of You O, Lord.

Matthew 6:9 “In this manner, therefore, pray; Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.”

**Day 28: (November 5)** Pray Your kingdom come and Your will be done. Help us to die to ourselves O Lord to prefer Your kingdom and Your will over our own.

1 John 2:17 “And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but how does the will of God abide forever.”

**Day 29: (November 6)** Pray On earth as it is in heaven. Increase our sensitivity to the fact that this is not our permanent home and give us an eternal perspective that we might daily declare the glory of the Lord.

Psalm 19:1 “The heavens declare the glory of God and the firmament shows His handiwork.”

**Day 30: (November 7)** Pray give us this day our daily bread. Let us feast on You.

Isaiah 58:2 “Yet they seek Me daily, and delight to know My ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and did not forsake the ordinance of their God. The ask of Me the ordinances of justice; they take delight in approaching God.”

**Day 31: (November 8)** Pray forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.

Ephesians 4:32 “And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.”

**Day 32: (November 9)** Pray lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. May I be led by only You Lord.

Psalm 23:2b-3 “He leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name’s sake.”

**Day 33: (November 10)** Pray For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. For You are and there is none besides You.

1 Chronicles 17:20 “O LORD, there is none like You, nor is there any God besides You, according to all that we have heard with our ears. Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please God, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

**Day 34: (November 11)** Pray for any woman in attendance that has not received Jesus Christ as her personal Savior and Lord. May she be led to Christ this weekend.

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.”

**Day 35: (November 12)** Pray for everyone in attendance to be built up and strengthened in the Lord. The enemy is attempting to wear down the saints of the Highest One.

Daniel 7:25 “He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, and shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand for a time and times and half a time.”

**Day 36: (November 13)** Pray that every woman in attendance has the fruit of the Spirit in abundance.

Galatians 5:22-23 “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.”

**Day 37: (November 14)** Pray for all the women attending conference to leave reflecting the glory of the LORD.

2 Corinthians 3:18 “And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is Spirit.”

**Day 38: (November 15)** Pray for excitement to increase within the ladies for Worship and Study. Pray for our desire to draw closer to Him to increase.

Colossians 1:9-10 “And so from the day we heard we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;”

**Day 39: (November 16)** Pray for every woman attending conference to enter this conference with praise.

Psalms 100 “Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands! Serve the LORD with gladness; come before His presence with singing. Know that the LORD, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations.”

**Day 40: (November 17)** Pray that all will praise the Lord among the nations as women from all nations gather together for Worship and Study.

Psalms 57:9-11 “We will praise You O Lord among the nations, and sing of You among the peoples for great is Your love reaching to the heavens, Your faithfulness reaches to the skies. Be exalted O God among the heavens and let Your glory be over all the earth.”
