

“Royal Ambassadors”



Objective: Women will be challenged as Christ’s ambassadors (His personal representatives) to represent the King of Kings here on earth, living in such a way that others will want to be reconciled to God. II Corinthians 5:20–21 amp “So we are Christ’s ambassadors, God making His appeal as it were through us. We [as Christ’s personal representatives] beg you for His sake to lay hold of the divine favor [now offered you] and be reconciled to God. For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.”

Scriptural Emphasis: 1 Peter 2:9–10 But you are a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

Speaker Emphasis: We have been delivered from the kingdom of darkness and Satan’s power through the victorious, redemptive work of Jesus Christ. In order to properly represent the King, we must know Him through intimacy. I’m reminded of the verse in Daniel 11:32b “but the people who know their God shall be strong and carry out great exploits.” We have been chosen as a people, a royal priesthood to carry out great exploits for God. As His ambassadors we are being conformed into the image and likeness of Christ Jesus. We decrease and He increases. Our light begins to shine bright. That light brings hope to a

lost world. When we truly represent Him, that light can be used of God to cause those in the kingdom of darkness to be reconciled unto God.
